1. Adoptions – Saturdays at PetSmart from 1 to 5 p.m. Adults, assist with finding homes for our homeless animals and completing paperwork. Minors assist with caring for the pets, i.e. taking outside for potty breaks.
2. Adoptions – Saturdays at the Shelter from 1 to 6 p.m. Adults, assist with finding homes for our homeless animals and completing paperwork. Minors guide potential adopters to pet areas and assist with their care, i.e. taking outside for potty breaks.
3. Laundry – Any day, to keep up with the huge amount generated daily.
4. Cat Care – Any day, at PetSmart and at the shelter. Clean cages, give fresh food and water and spend some time playing with them.
5. Cleaning Shelter – Daily, daytime or evening.
6. Cat and Dog Grooming – Bathing and brushing the animals.
7. Foster Home – Take animals into your home to help prepare them for adoption into a permanent home. Be willing to bring them to our adoption sites on Saturdays.
8. Shelter Repairs and Mowing – Any day. Most repairs are minor. If you have experience with any type of repairs and would like to help, we certainly would appreciate it. Summertime mowing is essential to help keep the ticks away.
9. Fund Raising – We offer bake sales and craft shows every few weeks at PetSmart. We could use help with the baked goods and the craft items that we sell, particularly the pet/people blankets made of fleece. If you have an interest in helping in this area, there's always a need.
10. Muttfest – Our biggest fundraiser of the year is held in May each year at Memorial Park. We need people who will procure items for our silent auction and who are willing to give up one Sunday for the event and time and effort for preparation and planning several weeks before the event. Ideas are always welcome!
